The government of Canada is offering, through the Canadian Revenue Agency (CRA), an accelerated capital cost allowance (CCA) incentive of 50% on qualifying solar power systems, to encourage businesses, farms and ranches to adopt renewable energy technologies.

How it works:

- Peace Energy Co-op designs and installs a solar power system that will replace costly grid electricity with inexpensive solar power for your business, farm or ranch. This immediately reduces your overhead and continues to reduce it more and more over the years as the cost of grid power goes up and up.
- Generating your own solar electricity insulates your business from the inevitable yearly increases in the cost of grid electricity and reduces or eliminates your electrical bills for decades to come.
- As a business under the CRA program, you can depreciate your solar asset at up to 50% of it's cost per year, on a declining balance basis. This means you can recover the entire value of your solar power system in as little as five years.
- As well as reducing or eliminating your electrical bills, your solar power system remains a valuable **business asset** increasing the value of your building or business.

- **Quick Facts:** 1) Most solar power equipment comes with **12 to 25 year warranties.**
 - 2) Alberta businesses are eligible for up to a 25% rebate on solar purchases.
 - 3) There is **no 7% sales tax** on solar power systems in BC.
