CANADA GREENER HOMES GRANT

Up to \$5600 available for energy savings upgrades for homes across Canada
including solar!

To qualify for the main project grant money (maximum of \$5,000) you must complete a pre- and post-project 'EnerGuide' home energy evaluation which has a separate grant stream available to a maximum of \$600/household to cover all or some of that cost.

Once your pre-project assessment and report are completed you can choose from the options as to which one(s) you would like to complete. **Solar should be listed as one of the options.** If you choose not to (or cannot) complete even one of the options in the report, then you will not be eligible for the evaluation grant money (\$600). CANADA GREENER HOMES GRANT

Up to \$5600 available for energy savings upgrades for homes across Canada

more info about the program:

The Canada Greener Homes Grant program aims to fight climate change, create new jobs for Energy Advisors across Canada, grow domestic green supply chains, and help homeowners make their homes more energy efficient, comfortable and affordable.

What's available through this program?

- 700,000 grants of up to \$5000 to help homeowners with energy efficient retrofits
- EnerGuide evaluations (worth up to \$600) and expert advice so homeowners can plan their retrofits
- Recruitment and training of EnerGuide energy advisors

Requirements to be eligible for the Canada Greener Homes Grant:

- You are a homeowner and are able to demonstrate that you primarily reside in the property
- The property is not a new construction
- You complete a pre- and post-retrofit EnerGuide evaluation
- Complete at least one retrofit that is eligible and recommended
- Provide and keep copies of all of your documents until March 2028
- All products must be purchased in Canada or ordered from an online distributor in Canada

To be eligible for solar panel installation under the Canada Greener Homes Grant:

the system must be composed of solar photovoltaic (PV) panels and an inverter certified to CSA standards, all products must be purchased in Canada, and the rated PV array must have peak power capacity higher than or equal to 1.0 kW.

This grant will cover \$1000 per kW of installed solar panels for a single-family home, and batteries connected to a PV system that provide standby power for the home are eligible to receive \$1000. The battery installation must be done in conjunction with another retrofit.
