

Hudson's Hope Visitor Centre Goes Solar



Solar energy cuts Visitor Centre electricity costs in half

The 10.1 kilowatt solar array recently installed at the Hudson's Hope Visitor Centre will provide about 55% of the electricity the building uses, cutting their electrical bills in half for the next 30 years.

This is one of the eight locations that solar is being installed across the District of Hudson's Hope, which will total more than 500 kilowatts when completed later this year. This is the largest municipal solar project in British Columbia, demonstrating environmental leadership while greatly reducing the District's electrical costs for decades to come.
